1. Good morning everyone! I am deeply honoured to be here with everyone at Mid-Autumn Festival, to witness this important historical moment – the Opening Ceremony of the Renovated SCCCI Building. I sincerely thank everyone for attending today, especially PM Lee for taking time out of your busy schedule to officiate today's ceremony, and DPM Wong for delivering the Keynote Speech.
2. Looking back, the SCCCI Building was completed in 1964. At Mid-Autumn Festival that year, Founding Prime Minister Mr Lee Kuan Yew officiated the opening of the Building. In his speech, Mr Lee Kuan Yew encouraged the Chinese community to settle down and make Singapore their home and actively integrate themselves into

the multiracial Southeast Asian society, reflecting the concerns and challenges in that era.

We also support the Government's efforts in strengthening Singapore's defence capabilities – Singaporeans must not take social stability for granted. Only when we stay resilient and forge ahead, will we be able to safeguard our lives, freedom, dignity and economy!
  
8. The key to Singapore's success lies in a united, highly effective, honest, non-corrupt, meritocratic government highly trusted by the people! We trust and support the Government, especially in the Forward Singapore exercise launched by the Government after the pandemic, to strengthen our social compact and national identity, build shared values and strong emotional bonds among the diverse groups in the society.
  
9. The front and back facade of the renovated SCCCI Building have taken on a refreshing look with a traditional and modern design respectively. The respect for tradition symbolises the patriotism and integrity of Chinese entrepreneurs; the innovation that keeps up with the times symbolises the core values of succession and innovation, both of which complement each other, forming the basis of SCCCI's important mission – creating value for our nation and “Uniting Businesses”!
  
10. The SCCCI Building showcases the SCCCI Chinese Entrepreneurial Spirit, reflects the confidence of the Singaporean identity and is the home that creates value for the business community. Only when we unite Singaporeans and forge ahead
