\$10 Million Target Set for the SFCCA-SCCCI Joint Initiative "Grateful for the Present, Nurturing the Future" ("饮水思源、共育贤才") in Support of the Lee Kuan Yew Centennial Fund

The Singapore Federation of Chinese Clan Associations (SFCCA) and the Singapore Chinese Chamber of Commerce & Industry (SCCCI) are delighted to announce our joint initiative -- "Grateful for the Present, Nurturing the Future" ("饮水思源、共育贤才") in support of the Lee Kuan Yew Centennial Fund. The Lee Kuan Yew Centennial Fund was launched on 30 May 2023 to support the development of Singapore youth to become our future leaders, to pass on founding Prime Minister Mr. Lee Kuan Yew's visionary thinking, imagination, and determination, with a view to continue to shape Singapore's future as an exceptional nation.

The Chinese Community deeply appreciates Mr. Lee Kuan Yew's contributions, his leadership in building the modern Singapore and instilling in everyone the values which have given Singapore and Singaporeans a strong and respected character internationally despite our geographical constraints and strategic vulnerabilities. The intent of this joint initiative is to bring to Singaporeans' mind, particularly the next generation, of Mr. Lee Kuan Yew's contributions, his values and ideals that are still relevant for Singapore's present and the future.

SFCCA and SCCCI are collaborating with our networks of members, clans, affiliated schools, trade associations and community partners to galvanize Singaporeans from all walks of life to pledge their support for this initiative by signing on the signature books and





donating to the Lee Kuan Yew Centennial Fund. We encourage active participation in signing the signature books, valuing the significance of each signature regardless of the donation amount.

SFCCA and SCCCI will reach out to the Singapore Malay Chamber of Commerce and Industry, the Singapore Indian Chamber of Commerce and Industry, and the Eurasian Association, Singapore to invite them to join us to co-organize this initiative. Together, we aim to widen the pledging of support to our entire multi-racial community in this meaningful endeavor.

This joint initiative will continue until 15 September 2023. We are thankful that it has thus far received overwhelming support from many participating organizations and individuals. Our target is to raise \$10 million for the Lee Kuan Yew Centennial Fund to demonstrate our collective contribution towards this endeavor.

We plan to present the sum of donations and signatures in a ceremony on 15 September 2023 witnessed by Deputy Prime Minister Lawrence Wong. It will also serve to commemorate the 100th anniversary of Mr. Lee Kuan Yew's birth, express our appreciation for his contributions to Singapore, and affirm our collective commitment to pass on his beliefs, values, and principles to the succeeding generation.
