This panel will comprise distinguished leaders from the international and regional political and business sectors to provide strategic foresight and market insights.

b. Seizing Growth Opportunities in ASEAN

Leveraging on our extensive experience in international markets, SCCCI will support Singapore enterprises in forging strong partnerships to seize the opportunities in ASEAN. This includes capitalising on the opportunities presented by the Johor-Singapore Special Economic Zone, deepening industrial cooperation between ASEAN, China and global markets, and unlocking the full potential of ASEAN's economic integration.

c. Driving Industry Transformation, Strengthening Workforce Upskilling

In response to rapid technological advancements, intensifying competition, and evolving industry demands, SCCCI will provide more targeted and effective support for businesses. We will enhance cross-industry collaboration among trade associations and chambers, offering high-quality talent development and providing resources to facilitate business transformation.

d. Venturing into New Frontiers, Bringing in New Members from Emerging Sectors

To harness the opportunities brought about by the global technological revolution, SCCCI will broaden our membership base, in particular to attract enterprises from emerging sectors such as the green economy, digital economy and artificial



intelligence, in order to leverage one another's strengths and facilitate win-win cooperation.

e. Upholding the Chinese Entrepreneurial Spirit, Nurturing Outstanding Young Entrepreneurs

SCCCI will expand its network of young entrepreneurs across institutes of higher learning and the business community to nurture a new generation of young Chinese entrepreneurs who are strong and innovative leaders. At the same time, we will continue to nurture the next generation of talent through the SCCCI Scholars Network, empowering them to become the future pillars of our society.

Ladies and Gentlemen, SCCCI has journeyed through 119 years of transformation and progress, while Singapore has achieved six decades of remarkable growth, reaching a key milestone of SG60 this year! SCCCI always progresses with the nation, grows with the business community, and advances with the society.
