The Guangdong-Hong Kong-Macao Greater Bay Area (GBA), which includes nine cities in Guangdong Province as well as Hong Kong and Macao, is poised to become a global leader in technological innovation. The region's technological advancements are expected to have a profound impact on various industries, particularly in areas where it already has a strong foundation. This market study aims to guide participants in exploring the economic growth, technological innovation, and market opportunities within the GBA, with a focus on the transformation and upgrading of traditional manufacturing industries, cross-border trade and investment opportunities, and the prospects for smart city development.
